




Introduction

Our aim is to help people through education, appropriate technology and self-help projects to improve their living standards. The organization was founded in 1992. Present projects are children's homes, day-care centers, coffee plantations, informal vocational training, providing appropriate water filter systems, supplying water through pump systems and education at rural schools.

The staff members of the foundation are from various local ethnic tribal groups in Thailand







Organizational Overview

Noh Sah Ki is 6 years old She was born in a very poor family, and a few years ago her father got cancer. The family could not afford to send their 4 children to school, that's why a couple of years ago the children went to live to Mae Hae children home.

Now she lives in a safe and nurturing environment. She can go to school every day, and can eat 3 times a day.

Suda is 6 years old, and a few months ago she entered our foster children program. Her family is very poor, and cannot afford to buy food every day, especially fruits and vegetables. From the lack of vitamins Suda had lost almost all her hair.

With the help of the foster children program her family can give her proper food. Now she has gained almost 5 kg, and her hair is growing back.


