

Since we started our English teaching program in the mountain schools in northern Thailand our students have improved their grades in an average of 40%!


Thank you to all the volunteer English teachers that have helped us achieve this, without your effort this wouldn't have been possible.






Water supply for a village

In February we finished another water supply system for a remote village in the mountains of northern Thailand We used an hydraulic ram pump which operates without outside power like gasoline or electricity. All the villagers helped and we could install the water tanks, pump and pipelines within 3 days!


As the dry season approaches, most villages in these areas fear the lack of water for their basic needs. With this pump they can now be sure to have enough water for drinking, showering, washing and toilet.




More than 100 families received safe and clean drinking water in 2014
